

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE'S TRAIN FRAME

Photographs are a special way to remember events. What better activity at a Thomas party than a Thomas photo frame? Photos of the birthday boy with his friends are a wonderful and personal addition to a thank you note...or rather, a TANK YOU note!

The following activities are designed for parents and children to do together. Supervision of children with materials such as glue, scissors, etc is strongly recommended.

Time: 15 Minutes

To prepare Thomas Train Frame, you will need the following cargo:

- Unfinished wooden frame(s)
- Acrylic paint in red, blue, black, yellow brown
- Brushes in assorted sizes
- Add-on decorations, such as foam stickers in the shape of trains, railroad signs, unfinished wooden trains, etc.

The Right Track:

1. Using the brown paint with a medium brush, paint tracks around the perimeter of your frame.
2. When they are dry, add details – black wheels and buffers, yellow numbers, etc.
3. Glue the dry trains on to the frame in a race to the finish!
 - a. A less messy alternative is to use foam stickers to decorate the train tracks.
4. Insert a photo of your aspiring engineer, or a picture of the train parade from your child's birthday party!
